Literacy

- Daily VCOP challenges will be posted to develop writing skills.
- Reading Comprehension will be posted on Google Classroom throughout the week. There is a poster discussing the weekly skill focus.
- Writing will be posted on a Wednesday.
- Opportunities for listening and talking will be posted on a regular basis including presenting.
- Please get in the habit of using Epic! to read for enjoyment.

Numeracy and Maths

- Monday the focus will be place value.
- Tuesday the focus will be money (maths).
- Wednesday the focus will be multiplication and division.
- Thursday the focus will be algebraic thinking.
- Friday the focus will be fractions, decimals and percentages.

I am posting strategy videos alongside activities to support with learning. I am respond to questions pupils find tricky by posting a video response. I am also experiment with quiz videos to support with learning.

Our topic focus is <u>This Is... Scotland</u>. Each week we are taking an interesting focus for pupils to research. This is being linked with writing and art wherever possible. We will be looking at myths and legends, Scotland's geography, the Flannan Isle Mystery, Robert Burns and far more!
