In Numeracy, we will be focusing on 5 domains each week which include number sequences and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, equations and algebra, fractions, percentages and decimals.

In Maths we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of angles.

As we continue to enjoy our 1:1 devices provided, we will continue to use Chromebooks to support and enhance learning in the classroom. We will focus on developing our digital literacy skills as well as building on our knowledge of digital citizenship to help keep ourselves safe online.
